
Dear Board of Supervisors,

I am writing to ask you to remove a parcel of my property from the Moorman's River Agricultural/Forestal district. I have decided to sell 10 acres of land located within parcel 29-15c. The land is located on Georgetown Farm in Free Union, Virginia. I wish that the remaining acres of parcel 29-15c to go back into Agricultural/Forestal zoning.

I have included a plat of the property in question, along with a detailed land survey designating the 10 acres to be removed for sale. Since I am unaware of the Policies of Albemarle County in these matters, I am ready to exclude the entire area included in tax map 29-15c, and then reinstate the residue acreage in the A/F district after the 10 acre sale.
