Dear Crozet Residents,

You are cordially invited to attend the ***Crozet Town Meeting*** to learn more about how the Crozet Master Plan is taking shape in your community. Topics will include the **new Crozet Library**, the **streetscape and other downtown enhancements**, the **Old School Reuse Study final report**, and the **completed Master Plan for Western Park**. The town meeting is being co-sponsored by Albemarle County and the Crozet Community Advisory Council and will be held on:

7:00 pm- 9:00 pm: *Program*

After *Meet & Greet* at 6:30, the program will start with presentations to the whole group about the status of current projects (please see the enclosed fact sheet for an overview of the projects) followed by time for residents to talk with County staff members and consultants about individual projects. Crozet Community Advisory Council representatives will also be on hand to talk with you about your thoughts on current developments and opportunities for future involvements in these efforts.

Last year, over 40 community or committee meetings were held for Crozet projects, with Crozet residents logging over 1000 hours of participation. We encourage those of you who haven't yet served on a County committee or attended a town meeting or workshop to join us on September 24. Your participation is so important to successful master plan implementation.
