DOWNTOWN CROZET STREETSCAPE PROJECT Phase 2



Crozet residents are invited to a Community Meeting for the Downtown Crozet Streetscape Project Phase 2 to provide input on the conceptual design and the impacts related to implementing the vision for Crozet Avenue and New Main Street on Monday, December 3 at 7:00 PM at Western Albemarle High School.

This meeting will be sponsored by Albemarle County and project consultant Kimley-Horn and Associates and will be held in conjunction with the regularly scheduled Crozet Downtown Association Meeting.

The Downtown Crozet Streetscape Project Phase 2 is focused on Crozet Avenue from approximately 200' south of Tabor Street to just south of the CSX railroad underpass. The project begins the construction of New Main Street from Crozet Avenue to provide access for the proposed Downtown Crozet library. The Downtown Crozet Streetscape Project Phase 2 is an essential step in achieving the goals of the master plan by improving pedestrian connectivity within downtown Crozet, providing economic benefits and increased vitality for business owners, balancing the needs of all users including vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists, and aesthetically enhancing the entry way and main thoroughfare of downtown.

Over the last few months, the consultant team has been meeting with many stakeholders along Crozet Avenue to develop design possibilities that balance protection of existing features with the goal of an attractive, viable pedestrian friendly thoroughfare along Crozet Avenue from The Square to just south of Tabor Street. As the County and the Consultant team continue the dialogue with the public on this project, we will present the results and the preferred design of the conceptual design process for the streetscape improvements. We are seeking to refine the vision for the streetscape project improvements as the design begins to take shape.
