


DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

I, the undersigned, as County Executive and Director of Emergency Management for Albemarle County, Virginia, find the imminent threat of potential injury to persons and destruction of public and personal property to be of sufficient severity and magnitude as a result of the effects of Hurricane Florence to warrant coordinated local government action to prevent or alleviate any potential damage, loss, hardship, or suffering. Therefore, pursuant to Code of Virginia § 44-146.21, as amended, I hereby declare the existence of a Local Emergency in Albemarle County, Virginia beginning September 11, 2018 at 11:00AM

In accordance with this Declaration, the Office of Emergency Management and all other appropriate County agencies are hereby vested with, and authorized to carry out, all powers, duties and functions prescribed by State a local laws, rules, regulations and plans as may be necessary to adequately and appropriately respond to said Local Emergency.
