

# Belvedere Boulevard Bond Project - Phase 2

### Look Ahead

#### Street Contract

- Contractor has picked up the sign posts & frames needed and plans to install them Monday and Tuesday.
- The new painting subcontractor will be removing all the peeling paint, preparing the curbs for painting, and painting the curbs. It's possible he may start some of the paint removal this weekend.
- We will continue to monitor seeded & mulched areas for germination & growth. We are also addressing restoration of the portions of the wood mulched median in Belvedere Blvd that were impacted by the curb demolition/reconstruction.
- Early this week we expect to issue a notice to proceed to vendor providing the video inspection and cleaning of the storm inlets & piping system.
- Design consultant is finalizing the as-built plans required for VDOT and ACSA acceptance.

#### Landscape Contract:

- Landscaper contractor has been notified of the dead street-side Willow Oak at 760 Belvedere Blvd and two additional trees at 729 and 744 Cole Street. Based on our inspection today, the contractor will also be notified of other trees that apparently did not survive the winter. All of these replacements are covered by the contractor's one year warranty.

#### Stormwater Management Basins Contract

- Basin #1A (along Belvedere Blvd near future Senior Center) – is substantially completed. There are some minor grading touch-ups to be done and measures to assure the slopes are stable until grass is established.
- Basin #5 plantings are to be completed (some need to be replaced) and erosion areas will be stabilized.
- Will continue to monitor the seeded & mulched areas in Basins #3 and #4 for germination & growth.

#### Erosion & Sediment Control Contract

- Remove the temporary erosion & sediment control measures
- Seeded & mulched areas will be monitored for germination & growth. Area west of the tot lot & north of Belvedere Blvd needs to be over-seeded and mulched.
