



SUMMER RECREATION CAMP 2019

(Ages 6-13)

The Albemarle County Parks and Recreation Department will be sponsoring the Summer Recreation Camp at eight locations. This program is for children ages six to thirteen. The program consists of organized recreational activities, sports, games, contests, arts & crafts, and special events. This program is run in coordination with summer school.

- Child must turn six by November 30, 2019. (No Exceptions, this is a daycare license requirement)
- This program is open to all children in the age group.
- You do not have to attend summer school to attend the Summer Recreation Camp.
- Maximum of 100 participants for each location.
- **All locations will be CLOSED on July 4 and 5.**

***Cost of camp is a one-time fee (\$160), whether you attend one day, one week, or all 4 weeks, includes field trips to Albemarle County Lakes for swimming.**

Camp Responsibilities

- Children may not be dropped off before the program time begins and must be picked-up at the program ending time.
- Transportation is the parent's responsibility to and from the program site.
- Children need to bring lunch, snacks, and drinks each day.
- Staff cannot administer or store any medication.
- Children enrolled must be able to handle their own toileting, dressing, and eating.
