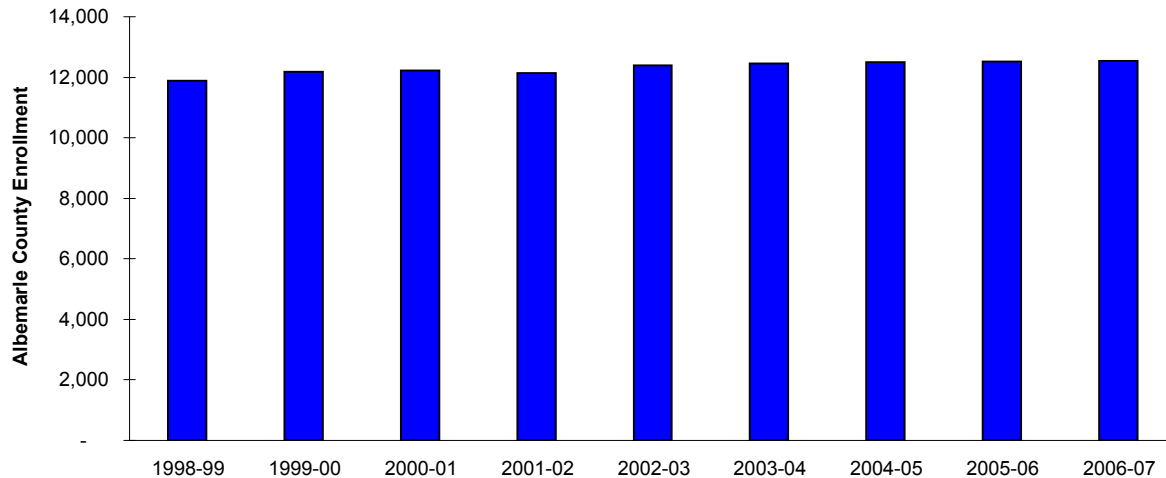

Albemarle County's June School Enrollment Has been Relatively Flat Since School Year 1998-99



Public School Enrollment

Since SY 1998-99, the County's schools have seen enrollment increase from 11,885 to 12,543. This total growth of 658 students, or 5.5%, translates into an average annual increase of about 82 pupils, or an average annual rate of increase of 0.67%. Note that, between SY 2002-03 and 2006-07, total enrollment grew by only 147 students, or 1.2%. During this time period, in other words, enrollments grew, on average, by 37 pupils per year, or at an average annual rate of increase of 0.30%.

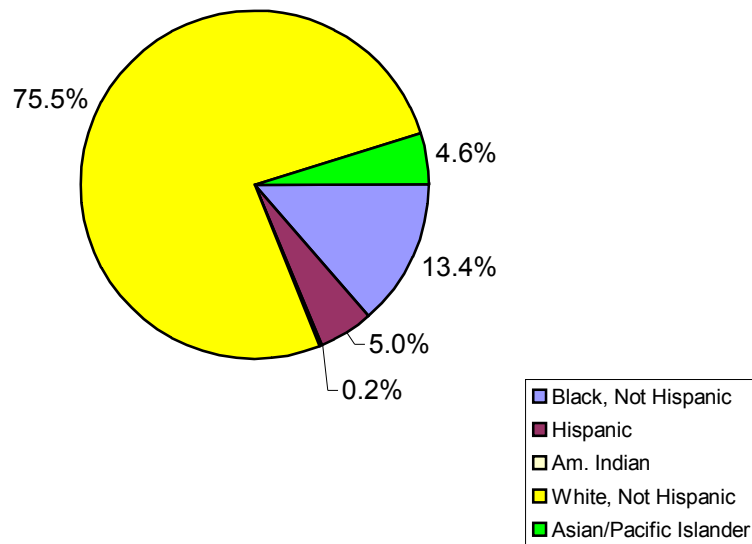

Albemarle County Schools Ethnic Distribution (SY 2006-07)

In 2006-07, whites continue to make up the largest percentage of the student population at roughly 76%. Non-Hispanic blacks continue to make up the second largest ethnic group, comprising about 13% of all students.
