**Question 1) On page 1 of your RFP you state “Period of Contract: For One (1) Year from the Date of final Execution with the Option for FOUR (4) Additional One (1) Year Renewals.” However, page 8 states “ACPS will entertain service terms of one to ten years, unless otherwise restricted”. These two statements are mutually exclusive, the district can’t have a period of contract for one (1) year from the date of final execution with the option for four (4) additional one (1) year renewals, AND, entertain service terms of one to ten years.**

**This brings up a 2<sup>nd</sup> issue which is the term “the date of final execution” above. Given a construction scenario it is possible that the final execution of the contract would be later than the execution of the contract date (for example: the district could have a signed contract by 6/30/2025, but the final execution of the contract would be on the day that the network is turned over to the district – or the date the district accepts the service as complete).**

**Answer 1)**

- The terms listed on page one are the county’s standard contract terms, which are correct. Page 8 states that ACPS will entertain service terms from one to 10 years, however contract terms exceeding the standard terms stated in the RFP **are not guaranteed**.
- Items for negotiation may be included with the proposal, the terms are specified in the RFP.
- Bidders are free to propose anything that is not expressly forbidden by the RFP.

**Question 2)**

**It appears that the RFP is seeking to address your fiber / cabling needs and does not mention Wireless Access Points and similar equipment as part of your overall infrastructure. Does ACPS require any products or services outside of cabling and related services as part of this RFP?**

**Answer 2) Bidders are free to propose anything that is not expressly forbidden by the RFP.**

**Question 3) For the bond requirements, do the bonds need to be submitted as part of the proposal or upon award?**

**Answer 3) The bond wording was listed in the sample contract and is not required at this time. Please note ACPS construction projects would/may require additional insurance, bonds etc.**
