Members of the public may attend the Canvass of Results in person. Due to the prolonged nature of this meeting, the limited attendance at the Provisional Ballot Meeting, and the facilities, this meeting is not available for remote participation. Note that the Provisional Ballot and Canvass portions of the meeting will be recessed and reconvened from time to time as necessary until the results are certified. The Canvass of Results will include results from Early Voting, Mail-In Absentee Voting, Post-Election Absentee Voting, Provisional Voting, and Election Day Precinct Voting. The Provisional Ballot portion of the meeting must complete before the Canvass and the Canvass must complete before Certification of results, but otherwise the Provisional and Canvass processes may be interleaved.
