Proposed Marker Text for Union Run Baptist Church

Union Run Baptist Church, formerly named Union Branch Baptist Church was organized by Rev. Robert Hughes (1821-1895) and other freedmen shortly after the Civil War ended. Spiritual life was vital to the freedmen and establishing churches and creating communities were of primary importance. In 1867, a deed of gift for one acre of land was presented to the deacons of the church by Thomas Jefferson Randolph. The congregation soon purchased the Old Limestone Church building and re-erected it on this site. Rev. Hughes led the worship services for three decades until his death and is interred in the churchyard. The Church celebrated its 150th anniversary in 2015 and remains a cornerstone in the community.
